salk facts

- The Salk Institute for Biological Studies was established in 1960 by Jonas Salk, developer of the polio vaccine.
- The Institute was developed with \$20 million seed money from the March of Dimes and land gifted by the City of San Diego.
- Jonas Salk hired world-renowned architect Louis Kahn to design a collaborative, unobstructed facility adaptable to the ever-changing needs of science.
- The American Institute of Architects (AIA) rated the Salk one of the nation's top ten buildings of the 20th century and one of 31 buildings that changed modern life.
- Research priorities: Cancer, Dynamic Brain, Genomic Medicine, Healthy Aging and Plant Biology
- The Institute has trained more than 2,700 scientists.
 - Impact studies by Science Watch measuring scientific citations have ranked Salk scientists among the world's leaders in neuroscience, molecular biology, genetics and plant biology and its faculty members are cited more frequently than any other researchers in their fields.
